Thanks to everyone who participated in the Governing Board meeting. We successfully completed the agenda in a timely manner. The discussions were valuable in moving Family RV Association forward.

We have had some changes in staffing. Trinity Stewart, Membership Assistant, has chosen not to return from leave in order to focus on her young family. Brandon Jones, Graphics Designer, has decided to further his education. Jill Jaiswal has returned as Graphics Designer. She is a former staff member who had been laid off. Many of you had the opportunity to meet Whitley Jones, our Director of Marketing, at the National Convention.

We have moved \$200,000 from our deferred dues investment account to our operating accounts to assure that all of our bills continue to be paid on time without incurring late fees or penalties.

Danielle Powell and Penny Gortemiller have begun a series of training sessions on the Chapter module of Horizon. We urge all chapter officers to attend these training sessions to better understand and utilize the capabilities of the Chapter module.

The Ambassador Program under Wayne Cernie's leadership is getting organized and developing marketing material. The goal is to increase our membership by a minimum of 7,000 by the end of the 2027 fiscal year. They will be coordinating FRVA presentations and presence at RV shows, events and campgrounds throughout the year. Please participate by helping to represent us at a local event.
