

## THE COUNTDOWN IS ON!

We're just weeks from the start of Family RV Association's 110th International Convention & RV Expo at the Georgia National Fairgrounds & Agricenter in Perry, GA. I hope you are as excited as we are to get the show started.

During your registration for the event, you indicated that you wished to have your confirmation packet held at Will Call. The confirmation packet includes several items you should have before arriving in Perry. We thought it would be a good idea to provide you with all the pre-convention information that other attendees have received through the mail to ensure you are up to speed with everything planned for the event.

Confirmation Guide that includes much of the nuts-and-bolts information needed to get you to Perry and help you get settled. **Please follow the directions indicated in the Confirmation Guide when arriving in Perry.** Do not totally rely on a map or GPS to get you to the Welcome Area. We worked closely with the local law enforcement agencies to get you off the highway and to keep traffic moving smoothly onto the grounds.

A second attachment is a Will Call parking card that we ask you to print out and tape to the lower right-hand section of the driver-side windshield. This will help parkers identify the RVs that must be directed to Will Call before being staged to park, making the parking procedure more efficient.

### ARRIVAL DATES –

Below are the dates you should arrive, depending on your requested participation level.

**General and Disabled Parking—The Arrival Date of Entry is listed in the email.** If you don't know, Call the FRVA Events Department to get your arrival date. You may arrive anytime on or after this date. **If you arrive after 5:00 p.m. on any day, go directly to the Welcome Area. You may camp there overnight, and it will be parked in the morning.**

Saturday, March 8 – Please arrive and get acclimated. On Sunday, March 9, RV Basics check-in and materials distribution will begin at 8:00 a.m. in Seminar 1, Miller-Murphy-Howard Building. Classes will begin at 9:00 a.m.
