Compared to previous RV A/C soft starters that must be wired directly to each A/C unit, the “plug & play” SoftStartUp means making wiring connections for installation are NOT needed. It just plugs into the main power supply. Then the RV owner plugs the RV into the SoftStartUp. (If an RV uses a surge arrestor for campground power pedestals, then the SoftStartUp plugs into the surge arrestor to maximize the RV’s power protection.)
